Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of January:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> In general, minimal supplies of fresh marine commodities were recorded in the monitored retail markets throughout the whole month. This may be attributed to the following: a) ongoing implementation of Closed Fishing Season in Northeastern Palawan (major fishing ground) for local galunggong from Nov 1 to Jan 31, Visayan Sea for sardines, herrings, and mackerels from Nov 15 to Feb 15 and Zamboanga Peninsula for sardines from Dec 1 to Mar 1; b) cold weather condition in the country brought about by the shear line affecting eastern section of Luzon and Visayas and Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon. Limited availability of local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were observed in all monitored retail markets throughout the month due to the closed fishing season at Northeastern Palawan on 1 November 2024 until 31 January 2025, which is the major source area for the said commodity. The prevailing retail price remained at a relatively high price of Php280.00/kg. There were other local galunggong varieties, such as "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>), and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) also observed. Due to the minimal supplies of local-fresh galunggong, more supplies of imported-frozen galunggong were reported at the monitored retail markets this month. Most of the vendors prefer selling imported commodity due to its availability and more affordable price, which made it easier for them to sell. Other imported frozen commodities, such as pompano, tulingan, chabeta, galunggong babae, pompano, salmon head and belly, and pusit kalawang, were also observed in most of the monitored markets. For alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>), less supplies were observed at the monitored markets due to the ongoing implementation of Closed Fishing Season in Visayan Sea for sardines, herrings, and mackerels from Nov 15 to Feb 15. Most of the available supplied were still large-sized and majority of the supply were mainly sourced from Malabon and Navotas Fish Port. The prevailing retail prices of bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>) and tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>) remained stable at Php160 & 180.00/kg and Php130.00/kg, respectively, due to the sufficient and stable supply noted in all monitored markets this month. Higher retail price were observed for Bangus sourced from Pangasinan due to its superior quality over supplies from Bulacan. Likewise, retail price of tilapia sourced from Batangas is higher compared to those from Pampanga, as most of the vendors preferred this due to its higher quality (in terms of taste). There is a Php20-30/kg price difference between live and dead tilapia observed. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Navotas and Malabon Fish Ports Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *<i>Epinephelus</i> sp. or Lapu-Lapy Red - (Php500.00 & 600.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg were recorded in the 1st and 2nd week at Malabon and Navotas Market where supplies were mainly sourced directly from nearby fishport like Navotas and Malabon Fish Port. Highest prevailing price of Php600.00/kg was also noted in the 4th and 5th week at Marikina and Munoz Market where supplies recorded were in secondary markets, hence, the higher price. *<i>Makaira</i> sp. or Malasugi - (Php500.00 & 600.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg were recorded in the 2nd week at Navotas Market where supplies were mainly sourced directly from Navotas Fish Port, hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php580.00/kg was also noted in the 5th week at Marikina Market where supplies recorded were in secondary markets, hence, the higher price. *<i>Sphyraena</i> sp. or Torsilyo - (Php200.00 & 300.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg were recorded in the 2nd and 4th week at Commonwealth and Pasig Market where supplies were mainly small size. Highest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was also noted in the 3rd and 5th week at Navotas and Guadalupe Market where supplies recorded were in large size, hence, the higher price.
