Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of January:

- Limited volume of supplies for fresh marine commodities were recorded at the Navotas Fish Port this month. This may be due to the following: a) ongoing implementation of Closed Fishing Season in Northeastern Palawan (major fishing ground) for local galunggong from Nov 1 to Jan 31, Visayan Sea for sardines, herrings, and mackerels from Nov 15 to Feb 15 and Zamboanga Peninsula for sardines from Dec 1 to Mar 1; b) cold weather condition in the country brought about by the shear line affecting eastern section of Luzon and Visayas and Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon.
- The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized local fresh galunggong laki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) remained relatively high at Php180-250.00/kg due to the minimal supplies unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port. This may be attributed to the closed fishing season at Northeastern Palawan from Nov 1 to January 31, which is a major fishing ground for the said commodity. Supplies were mostly sourced from areas including Zamboanga, Zambales, Ilocos Coast and Balabac Strait.
- More unloadings of imported frozen galunggong laki (*D. macrosoma*) were noted this month. Other imported commodities like galunggong babae (*D. russelli*) was also observed. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php 185.00/kg and were mainly sourced from Vietnam.
- Minimal unloadings of medium-sized alumahan were noted at the Navotas Fish Port this month. The prevailing wholesale price is at Php200.00/kg this month. Most of the supplies were sourced mainly from Bataan, Quezon Province and Masbate.
- Sufficient and stable unloadings of aquaculture commodities like Bangus and Tilapia were still reported at the Navotas Fish Port this month. Most of the supplies were recorded from Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan and Batangas, and Pampanga, respectively.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Ilocos Coast, Zambales, and Zamboanga, Basilan Strait
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam
 - Alumahan- Bataan, Quezon Province, Masbate, Zambales
