Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities were remain recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This could be attributed to the hampered fishing operations caused by the cold weather brought about by the Shear Line affecting Southern Luzon and the Visayas, as well as the Northeast Monsoon affecting the rest of Luzon¹. Relatively, minimal unloading of small to medium sized, local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded, with only two (2) broker unloaded a total of 6 metric tons (MT) on February 3, 2025 sourced from Zamboanga and Quezon Province and a total of 8 metric tons (MT) on February 5, 2025, with the supplies sourced from Zamboanga. The recorded actual wholesale prices were Php 100.00 and Php 113.00 per kilogram.
- Due to limited unloading of the local fresh variant, continues supply of medium-sized imported galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) was still noted at the fish port week, sold at a prevailing wholesale price of Php 180.00/kg, with the supplies sourced from Vietnam².
- On the other hand, three (3) brokers unloaded alumahan (*Rastrilleger kanagurta*) at the Navotas Fish Port on February 3 and 5, 2025, with a total of 8.4 metric tons (MT) at actual wholesale prices of Php138.00 and Php250.00 per kg. The supplies were sourced from Iloilo Straits, Ilocos Norte, and Masbate.
- Despite this, adequate supplies of aquaculture commodities such as bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) were recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. However, minimal unloadings of medium-sized (3-4 pcs/kg) bangus were recorded, as most of the supplies were of large sizes. These came from various sources, including Bulacan, Pangasinan, Laguna, Batangas, and Zambales. The actual wholesale price for medium-sized bangus was Php 120.00 per kilogram, predominantly sourced from Bulacan. Meanwhile, for medium-sized tilapia (*O. niloticus*), the prevailing wholesale prices were at Php 90.00 and Php 105.00 per kilogram, with the majority of supplies sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Zamboanga
 - Alumahan- Ilo-ilo Straits and Ilocos Norte
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam
