Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Still, limited unloading of fresh marine commodities were recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. More specifically, minimal unloading of medium-sized, local fresh galunggong laki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded, with only one (1) broker unloaded a total of 2.8 metric tons (MT) on January 21, 2025 sourced from Zamboanga and Zambales and a total of 2 metric tons (MT) on January 23, 2025, with the supplies sourced from Basilan Strait. The recorded actual wholesale prices of Php 138.00 to Php 200.00 per kilogram.
- Meanwhile, adequate unloading of medium-sized imported galunggong laki (*D. macrosoma*) was still noted at the fish port week, sold at a prevailing wholesale price of Php 185.00/kg, while imported galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) was sold at Php 140.00/kg, both sourced from Vietnam¹.
- Minimal unloading of alumahan (*Rastriliger kanagurta*) was noted at Navotas Fish Port this week. As recorded, only four (4) brokers unloaded the commodity on 23 January 2025 with a total of 13 metric tons (MT) at prevailing wholesale price of Php200.00/kg, with the supplies sourced from Quezon Province, Zambales, and Balabac strait.
- Stable unloading of aquaculture commodities such as (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), was recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. The actual wholesale prices for medium-sized bangus were at Php 105.00 and Php 110.00 per kilogram, sourced predominantly from Bulacan. Meanwhile, for medium-sized tilapia (*O. niloticus*), the prevailing wholesale prices were at Php 100.00 per kilogram, predominantly sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Zamboanga, Basilan Strait
 - Alumahan- Quezon Province
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

¹ Price data of imported-frozen galunggong laki were gathered through FIDSSD's price monitoring at Navotas Fish Port.
